Camp Kinnissippewa 4-H Registration

This year we will be using 4H Online to register for camp. Register now to ensure your spot. Registrations are handled on the first come, first serve basis. Here are some instructions to ease you into this process. If you have any questions contact our office at 715-538-2311 ext. 210.

Log into your family account and you will find your family's member list. Scroll to the bottom and find the section titled "Register A Member In An Event". Select the name of the member you want to register.

Then select the 4-H Camp Kinnissippewa 2017 event.

A series of boxes will appear at the bottom of the screen.

Click on the "Register" button for the desired position at Camp Kinnissippewa (4-H Camper- Base Camp, 4-H Camp Counselor, 4-H Camper-Outpost).

REGISTERING FOR THE EVENT

On the next screen you will be asked for specific information related to the event. This may include swimming level, canoeing level, bus pick up/drop off location, etc. Any required fields are in bold.

Click on the "Continue >>" button. If you missed any required fields, you will get an error message and the missing fields will be highlighted.

On the Payment screen, the only selection is County/Club 4H Check. Click on the "Select Payment Method" button. The payment shows as a fee of \$120 but for you can apply with the Leaders' Association to cover 50% of the cost of each camper. Counselors have their costs completely waived. On the Confirm screen, check the box agreeing to the Pay By Computer Terms and Conditions. Click the "Confirm Order" button. On the Finish screen, you can print your entry
