WHAT: A special camp offering instruction by knowledgeable trainers, English and Western pleasure, horsemanship/equitation, showmanship, horse safety, and much more! Learn from experience, examine new ideas and techniques, make new friends, and have FUN!

WHO: Open to any member of the Trempealeau County 4-H Horse Project, FFA and surrounding counties. Registration deadline is May 1, 2019. Camp is limited to 40 youth – registration is not complete until payment has been made in full.

WHEN/WHERE: June 13th, 14th & 15th at the Galesville Fairgrounds. Check in between Noon and 5pm on Thursday, June 28th. Camp concludes at 5pm on Saturday, June 30th. Horses may be dropped off Wednesday night however there will **NOT** be anyone at the fairgrounds to supervise them overnight. You are responsible for their well-being. Stalls are on a first come basis – *STALLS MAY NOT BE RESERVED AHEAD OF TIME*.

COST: Must be sent with registration form:

- ✓ \$100 per camper (includes t-shirt and meals)
- √ \$ 20 stall cleaning deposit (separate check please)

 This check will be returned if your stall and area in front of your stall is clean prior to leaving the fairgrounds. STALLS MUST BE INSPECTED BY CONNIE OR BECKY PRIOR TO LEAVING!

CAMP DISCOUNT: There is a discounted rate for those Trempealeau County youth who have turned in \$50 or more in sponsorships. Also, don't forget to request camp funding from the Leader's Board. Forms can be found at www.trempealeau.uwex.edu

WHAT TO BRING: Negative Coggins original paperwork, plus a copy (remember, the new test run from calendar date to calendar date) & Animal ID/Vet Inspection Form with your premise ID number. Proper tack (clean and in good condition). SEI approved safety helmet and hard soled boots or shoes (1/2" heal preferred). A complete list of items to bring will be provided prior to camp.

- Horses must be manageable and in good health. Campers are required to follow 4-H policy rules and will be in their tents by 10:30 PM. No visitors will be allowed on the premises past 10:30 PM!
- Food and monetary donations for meals are gladly accepted. Pot Luck lunch will be held on Saturday, all attendees are asked to bring a dish to pass.
- Arm bands will be provided for all paid campers. Parents and other family members may purchase armbands if they are eating at horse camp and did not pre-purchase their meals.
- Parents are encouraged to camp and participate along with their children.
- An adult must accompany campers sleeping in trailers. Exceptions MUST be discussed with Connie or Becky at the time of registration!
