

2021 TREMPEALEAU COUNTY 4-H HORSE CAMP

WHAT: Horse camp offers instruction by knowledgeable trainers covering various topics such as English, Western pleasure, horsemanship/equitation, showmanship, horse safety, and much more! Learn from experience, examine new ideas and techniques, make new friends, and have FUN!

WHO: Open to any member of the Trempealeau County 4-H Horse Project and horse project members from surrounding counties. Registration deadline is May 1, 2021. Horse Camp is limited to 40 youth; registration is not complete until payment has been made in full.

WHEN/WHERE: June 10th, 11th & 12th at the Galesville Fairgrounds. Check in between Noon and 5pm on Thursday. Camp concludes at 2pm on Saturday. Horses may be dropped off Wednesday night however there will **NOT** be anyone at the fairgrounds to supervise them overnight. You are responsible for their well-being. Stalls are on a first come basis – *STALLS MAY NOT BE RESERVED AHEAD OF TIME.*

COST: Must be sent with registration form:

- ✓ \$100 per camper (includes t-shirt and meals)
- ✓ **\$ 20 PER stall cleaning deposit (SEPARATE CHECK)**
This check will be returned if your stall and area in front of your stall is clean prior to leaving the fairgrounds. STALLS MUST BE INSPECTED BY RHEA OR BECKY PRIOR TO LEAVING!

OPTIONAL FEES: Must be sent with registration form:

- ✓ **Camping Fees:** \$30 for electrical/water sites
 - Please make checks payable to **Trempealeau Co. Ag Society**
- ✓ \$20 for extra T-shirts
- ✓ \$15 adult meals
- ✓ \$40 per day fee for daily camp participants

CAMP DISCOUNT: There is a \$20 discount for those Trempealeau County youth who have turned in \$50 or more in sponsorships. Also, don't forget to request camp funding prior to camp from the Leaders' Board. Forms can be found at www.trempealeau.uwex.edu

WHAT TO BRING: Negative Coggins original paperwork & Animal ID/Vet Inspection Form with your premise ID number. Proper tack (clean and in good condition). SEI approved safety helmet and hard soled boots or shoes (1/2" heel preferred). A complete list of items to bring will be provided prior to camp.

- 🌻 Horses must be manageable and in good health. Campers are required to follow 4-H policy rules and will be in their tents by 10:30 PM. No visitors will be allowed on the premises past 10:30 PM!
- 🌻 Food and monetary donations for meals are gladly accepted.
- 🌻 Arm bands will be provided for all paid campers. Parents and other family members may purchase armbands if they are eating at horse camp and did not pre-purchase their meals.
- 🌻 Parents are encouraged to camp and participate along with their children.
- 🌻 *An adult must accompany campers sleeping in trailers. Exceptions MUST be discussed with Becky PRIOR to the start of camp!*
