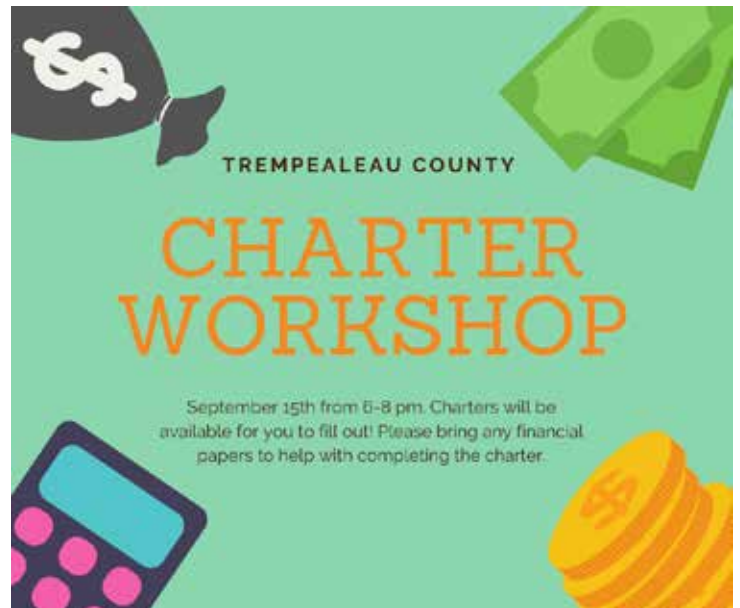


## Charter Workshops:

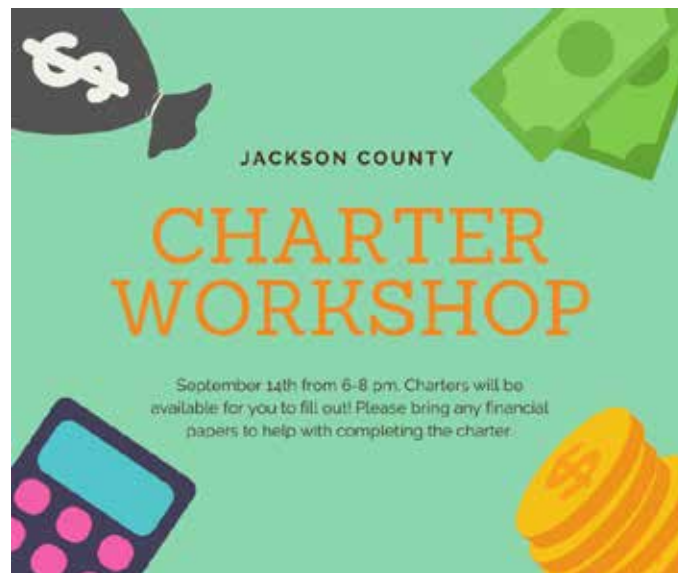

### **In-Person Meeting Approval Process**

As of July 1st, 2020, in-person meetings are possible! I have a post available on our website that gives you all of the details.

Here is a quick recap of some of the recent updates:

- As of June 2nd, masks are not required for fully vaccinated participants. Please visit the website to review the details.
- Pod-style meetings can happen outside (with up to 500 people) with no time limit.
- Indoor meetings have no size limit if participants are spaced 6 feet apart.

## VIP Training:

VIP or Volunteers in Preparation training is for anyone who wants to work with youth one-on-one and teach sessions like a project or club leader. If you have signed up to be a volunteer in 4-H Online and I have not approved you yet it might be because of this. Look for this symbol. This means that you will need to complete either VIP or mandated reporter training. The mandated reporter is an online course in 4-H Online that you can complete on your own time. VIP however, has to be taught by either myself or another educator virtually or in person. This training covers many topics on how to create a safe environment for youth and takes about 90 minutes.



I prefer to do VIP training on weeknights in September-April because the rest of the year gets pretty busy for everyone, especially in the summer.

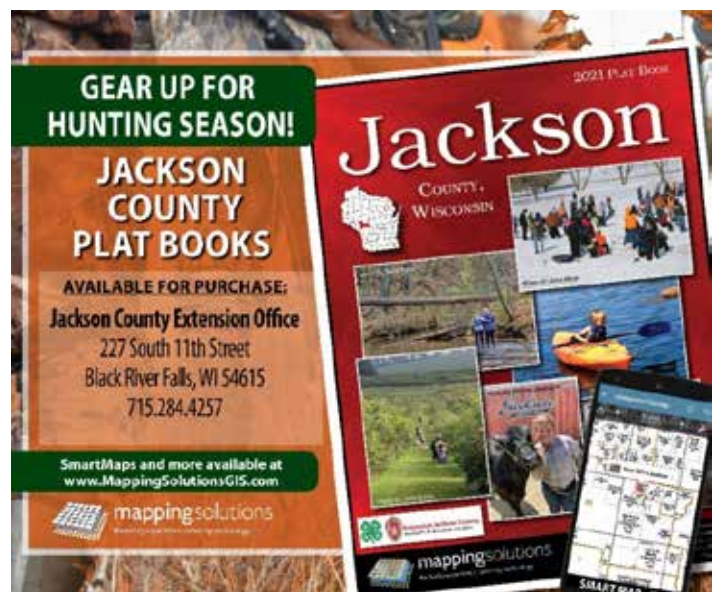
In this updated edition, the additional information includes a 4-H Club Locations Map, a School Districts Map, a Road Index, various Municipal Maps, and more.

## **Court House Meeting Room Changes:**

If you have driven through Whitehall Recently you might have noticed the construction happening at the courthouse. Because of this, the back doors we normally use to access the Trempealeau conference room are no longer available to us. This means for us to use the conference rooms groups have to be able to hire a Deputy to let us into the front door. I was told this change is currently in effect and will be for the foreseeable future. As the building finishes there will still only be one main entrance to the building. That means a Deputy will still be needed to use the meeting space's in the courthouse.

What does this mean for groups that use this space? I know many groups don't utilize the courthouse but for those that do an alternate spot will have to be used. Reminder, we have to adhere to ADA guidelines and use wheelchair-accessible buildings.

I am currently on the lookout for a space to have the Parents and Leaders meetings. I would prefer something close to Whitehall as it is the most central community in the county. I have a couple of programs scheduled at Riverland Energy in Arcadia.
