

What are Bronco Bux

Bronco Bux are points (bucks) that are earned during the current 4-H year through horse activities and events. At the end of the year during the annual banquet an auction is held. Allowing members to purchase items for their horse with their “bux”.

How to earn Bronco Bux

- Community Service Hours ~ Horse Project Related ~\$2/hr
 - 5 hours required
 - Community Service Hours ~ church, community, school, etc. ~ \$1/hr
 - Time with your Horse ~ riding, brushing, lunging, etc. ~ \$2/hr
 - Horse Related Tasks ~ fencing, barn or tack cleaning, haying, etc. ~ \$1/hr
 - Horse shows, sales, rodeos, clinic, expos, etc. ~ with horse ~ \$20/day
 - Horse shows, sales, rodeos, clinic, expos, etc. ~ without horse ~ \$10/day
 - Horse Project Officer ~ \$100
 - Parade Participation ~ \$5 per parade
 - Horse Project Meetings ~ \$20 per meeting
 - Coggins Clinic ~ \$20 per horse
 - T-Shirt Contests ~ \$5 per design (Limit 2)
 - Fair Participation ~ \$40/day
 - Horse Camp ~ with horse ~ \$40/day
 - Horse Camp ~ without horse ~ \$20/day
 - Organized Trail Ride ~ with horse ~ \$20/day
 - Organized Trail Ride ~ without horse ~ \$10/day
- (Organized trail ride is defined as a ride put on a group, that you are paying a fee to participate)

Bronco Bux points are tallied from October 1st – September 30th of the 4-H year. All Bronco Bux points are due no later than the October meeting of the new 4-H year.
