

What are Bronco Bux

Bronco Bux are points that are earned during the current 4-H year through horse activities and events. At the end of the year during the annual banquet an auction is held. Allowing members to purchase items for their horse with their “bux”.

How to earn Bronco Bux

- Community Service Hours ~ Horse Project Related ~\$2/hr (5 hours required)
- Community Service Hours ~ church, community, school, etc. ~ \$1/hr
- Horse Time ~ riding, brushing, lunging, chores, etc. ~ \$5/day
- 4H Horse shows, sales, rodeos, clinic, drill team practice/competition, camp, fair, expos, parades etc. ~ with horse ~ \$40/day
- 4H Horse shows, sales, rodeos, drill team practice/competition, clinic, camp, fair, expos, parades etc. ~ without horse ~ \$20/day
- Non 4H Horse shows, sales, rodeos, clinic, camp, expos, parades etc. ~ with horse ~ \$20/day
- Non 4H Horse shows, sales, rodeos, clinic, expos, parades etc. ~ without horse ~ \$10/day
- Organized Trail Ride ~ with horse ~ \$20/day
- Organized Trail Ride ~ without horse ~ \$10/day
(Organized trail ride is defined as a ride put on by a group, that you are paying a fee to participate)

No Longer Necessary to Track – VP will track on attendance sheet

- Horse Project Officer ~ \$100
- Drill Team Member ~ \$100
- Horse Project Meetings ~ \$20 per meeting
- Coggins Clinic ~ \$20 per horse
- T-Shirt Contests ~ \$5 per design (Limit 2)

Bronco Bux points are tallied from October 1st – September 30th of the 4-H year. All Bronco Bux points are due no later than the October meeting of the new 4-H year.
