Are you interested in the dog project?

The weather this week is reminding me of spring. This has me thinking of upcoming spring programing like the dog project! Dog obedience meets weekly in starting in April until the week before the fair. If you are interested in giving the dog project a try here are some requirements you will need to have done prior to the state of class. Your dog will have to have current vaccination in order to participate in class. A copy will have to be brought to the first session so it is wise to have this done now.

The foods and Clothing Review is coming up! Do you need ideas of what can be entered? Here are some samples: Class A Lot 7-14 Decorated Cookies, Decorated Cupcakes, Decorated Cakes.

Class A Lots 27-26 Tiered cake, with separators (any type of pillar and space between at least 1 layer) for a special occasion with a minimum of 5 tips or techniques used. Pre-make 3 flowers out of frosting that are uniform. Example: 3 roses. Bring on a plate suitable for display.



Class A Lot 37-40 Fudge, cooked candy (3) – Ages 7-19, Divinity, cooked candy (3) – Ages 7-19 and Molded candy (3) – Ages 7-19.

Clothing Review suggestions from Department 26J Class D-F Lot 1-17. simple top or vest, skirt with zipper, coordinated top or bottom, Dress for best wear (party, evening, formal), Sleep or loungewear.

The Foods and Clothing review is different from exhibiting at the fair. Clothing review gives you the opportunity to wear your garment and talk to the judge about it and how you made it. Foods review is a great opportunity to showcase your decorating skills or make some fantastic candies. Youth will get the opportunity to interact with the judge and gain valuable feedback on their progress.


