## Meetings:

- The 4-H year runs September 1 – August 31
- Meetings are held monthly except in December and August
- Meetings date, time and location are defined annually on the project calendar

## Requirements:

- ID Sheets – Due to Superintendent by April 1st
  - Choose 3 horses for clinics/fair
- Coggins test for each horse
  - Project holds a vaccination/Coggins & Farrier Clinic in the spring
  - Legal blood work/paperwork for state requirements
  - Need one annually
- Service hours- 5 service hours related to the horse project or other 4H or Horse event as approved by the Superintendent
- Sponsorships- Minimum of \$50 per child
- Meeting & Clinic Requirements
  - 4-H/FFA Members – 2 Horse Project Meetings
  - Non-4-H/FFA Members – 4 Horse Project Meetings
  - 1 Clinic with your fair horse
- Requirements due buy the July meeting to participate at the fair, unless otherwise specified
